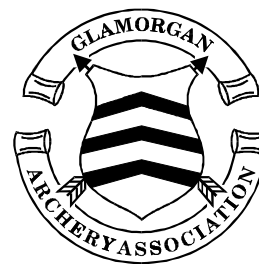

Glamorgan Briefing

The extremely popular Welsh Archery Association (WAA) Inter-County Championship will this year be hosted on behalf of Glamorgan by Cambria Bowmen on Saturday 11th September. The tournament is designed to give club archers in Wales the opportunity to compete in a high level team event, and provide a stepping stone to international archery.

For the last two years, Glamorgan have been narrowly beaten into 2nd place by Gwent, but I want to do better this year, especially as we're again hosting the competition! One of the ways that we can achieve this is by ensuring that we enter full teams in as many categories as possible.

Format

Each county can enter teams in any / all of the 8 categories listed below. Each team will comprise up to 4 archers, two male & two female (with the top 3 to score).

Categories: Senior Recurve, Senior Compound, Senior Barebow, Senior Longbow
Junior Recurve, Junior Compound, Junior Barebow, Junior Longbow

Senior Recurve & Compound will shoot -	6 dozen arrows @ 70m on a 122cm face
Senior Barebow & Longbow will shoot -	6 dozen arrows @ 50m on a 122cm face
Junior Recurve & Compound will shoot -	6 dozen arrows @ 50m on a 122cm face
Junior Barebow & Longbow will shoot -	6 dozen arrows @ 30m on a 122cm face

Eligibility & Selection

1. All archers taking part must be a member of Glamorgan Archery Association (GAA), and the Welsh Archery Association (WAA) at the time of the competition.
2. No senior archer who has represented Wales or GB since 12/09/2009 will be eligible.
3. Archers who have been members of a Welsh or GB squad, but whom have not actually REPRESENTED either, ARE eligible.
4. Preference will be given to junior archers who have not represented Wales or GB since 12/09/2009.
5. You must submit 3 scores from the current outdoor season for GNAS or FITA rounds, e.g. York, Hereford, Bristols, FITA, FITA 70, Metrics, or Field rounds. A mixture of rounds is acceptable. Details of tournament & date (as well as score) must be provided.
6. Tournament scores are preferred, and will be given preference over club shoots.
7. Scores to be submitted by 27/08/2010.
8. You must be available to compete on Saturday 11th September 2010.
9. Selection will be based on classification / average handicaps from scores submitted.
10. In the event of a tie between a GAA squad member & a non-squad member, preference will be given to the GAA squad member.

Team selection will be by invitation only from the selection panel. Selection will be based on classification / average handicaps from scores submitted.

Tournament scores will be given priority over club events or target days.
